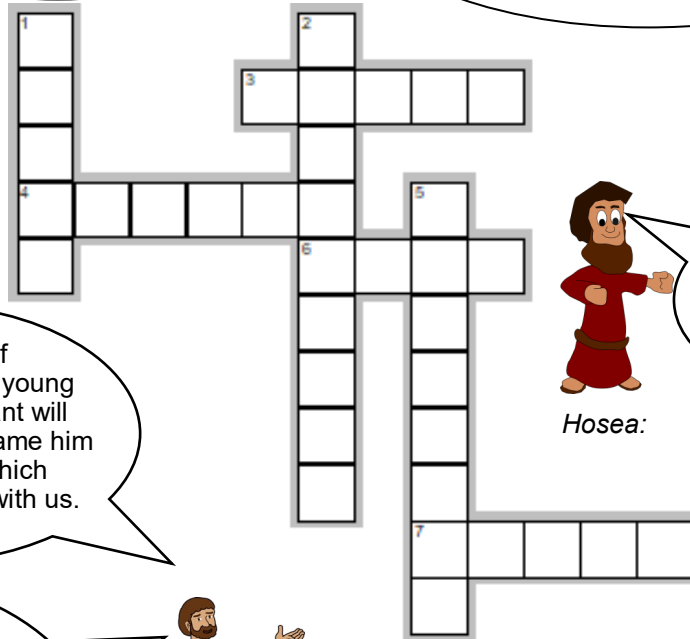
"The blind will be able to see, and the deaf will hear. The lame will leap and dance, and those who cannot speak will shout for joy."
