Be Thankful

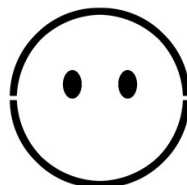
Jesus was traveling to Jerusalem. He went from Galilee to Samaria. He came into a small town, and ten men met him there. They did not come close to him, because they all had leprosy. But the men shouted, "Jesus! Master! Please help us!" When Jesus saw the men, he said, "Go and show yourselves to the priests."



While the ten men were going to the priests, they were healed. When one of them saw that he was healed, he went back to Jesus. He praised God loudly. He bowed down at Jesus' feet and thanked him. (He was a Samaritan.) Jesus said, "Ten men were healed; where are the other nine? This man is not even one of our people. Is he the only one who came back to give praise to God?" Then Jesus said to the man, "Stand up! You can go. You were healed because you believed."

Fact

Jesus told the lepers to go to the priest. By Jewish Law, the priest was the only one who could declare someone to be 'healed' and allow them to go back home again.



Jewish people looked down on Samaritans. Yet Jesus made no difference between them. He healed all 10 men! How do we sometimes treat people differently? Could we do better?
