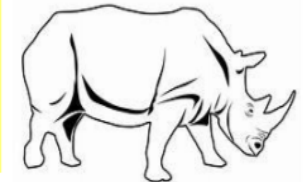

The **largest pancake** ever made was created in Manchester in 1994. It measured a whopping 15.01 metres in diameter and weighed 3048 KG (That's almost as much as a White Rhino!!!)



Pancake Day or Shrove Tuesday, is the day before the start of Lent. Lent is the six weeks before Easter. We remember Jesus being in the desert for 40 days. He prayed and went without food (fasting).

On **Ash Wednesday** people say 'SORRY' to God. Is there someone you should say 'sorry' to? Why not do that today?





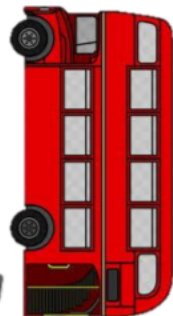

In the pancake draw or write something you are grateful for.

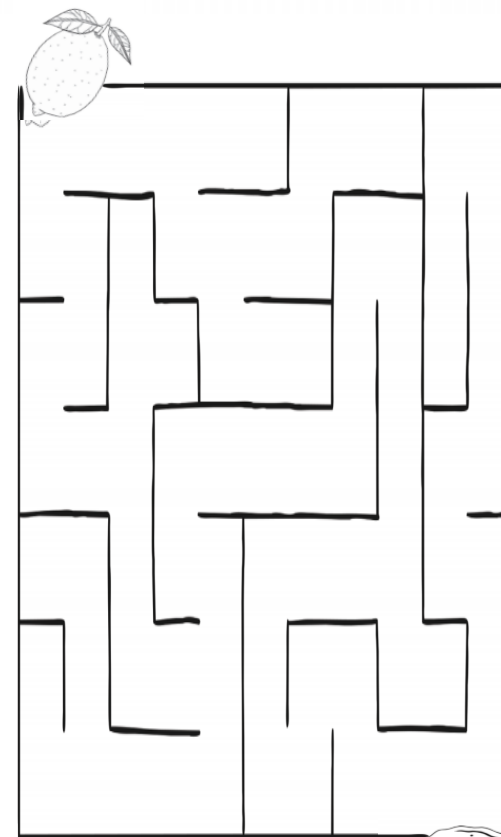
In 2010 in the U.S.A. Dominic Cuzzarcrea made a huge pancake flip measuring 9.47 m **high**.
