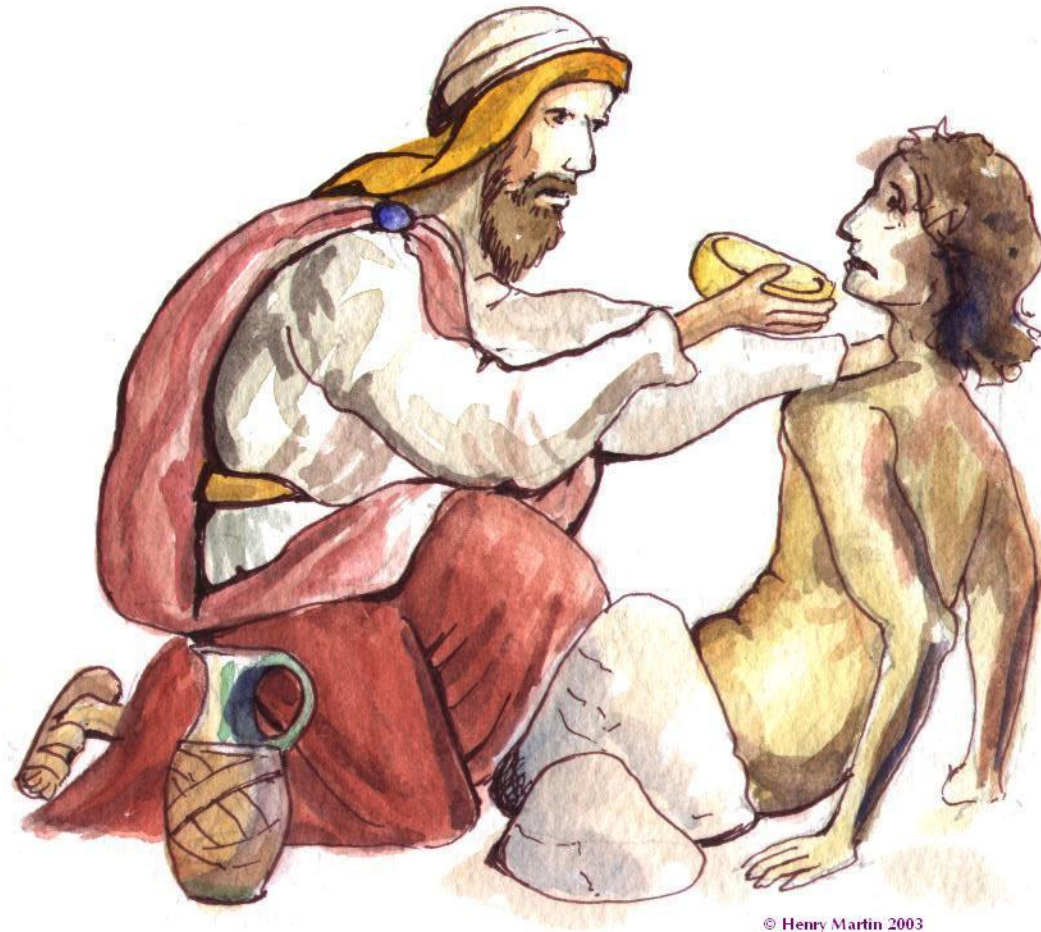

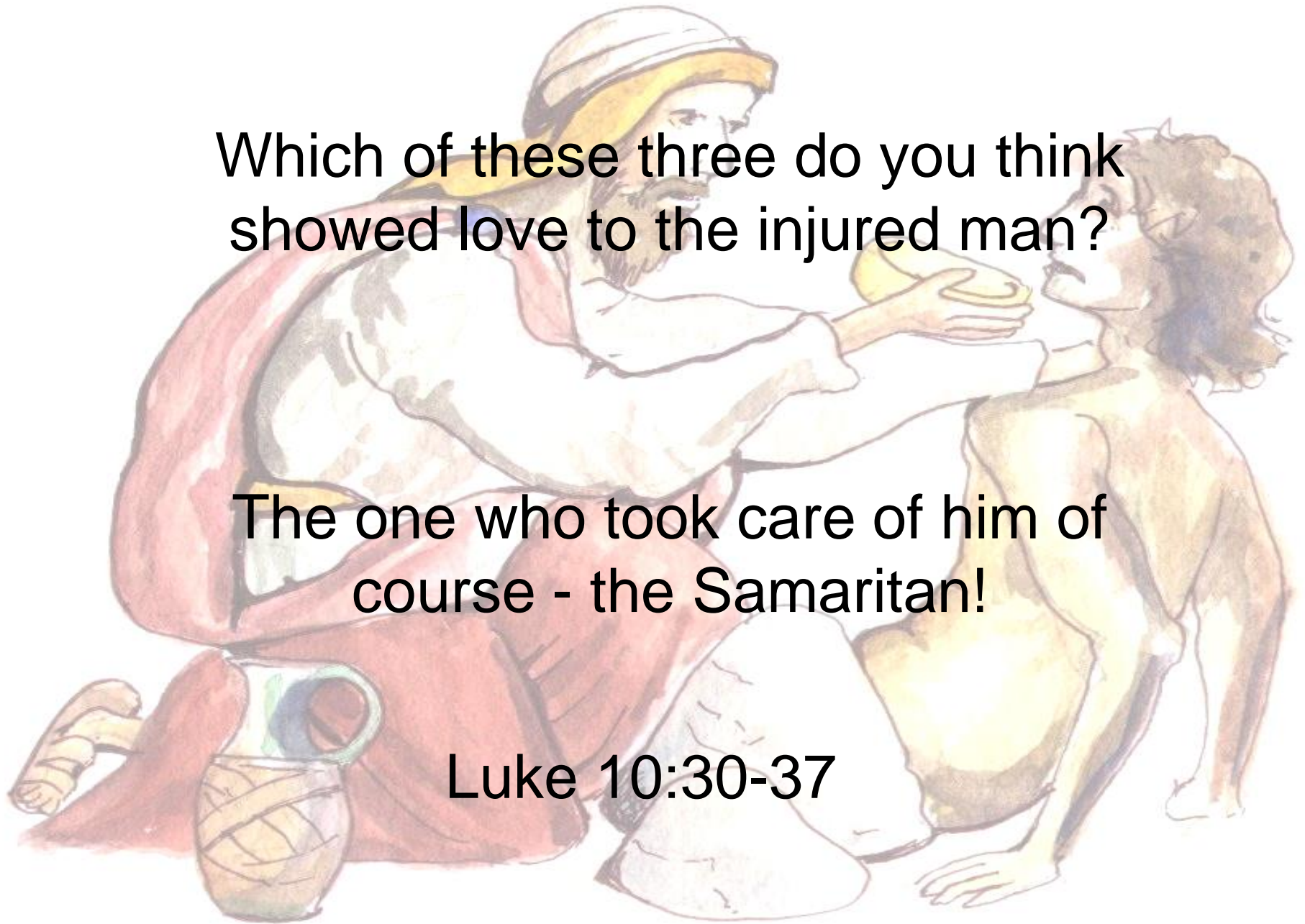
He took him to an inn and paid for his care.

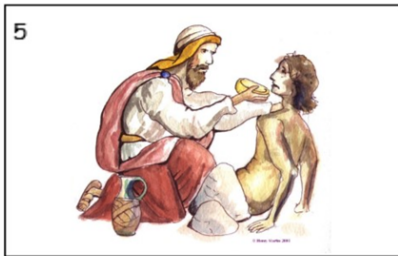
