Psalm 23

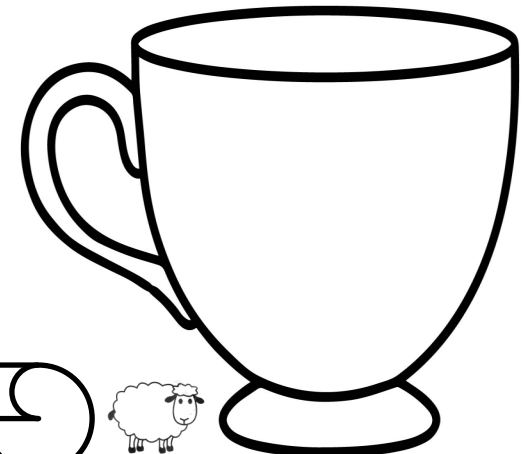
1. The Lord is my Shepherd.
